- Regional Capacity Building activities for WIO and GoA ongoing since DCoC signing in 2009.
- Activities countering piracy and armed robbery incidents against ships.
- The reduced numbers lead to expansion of the DCoC scope
- Other illicit maritime crimes provided for in the **Jeddah Amendment to the Djibouti Code of Conduct**
- Established governance framework - Steering Committee, Two Working Groups on Information Sharing & Capacity Building and Friends of the DCoC.

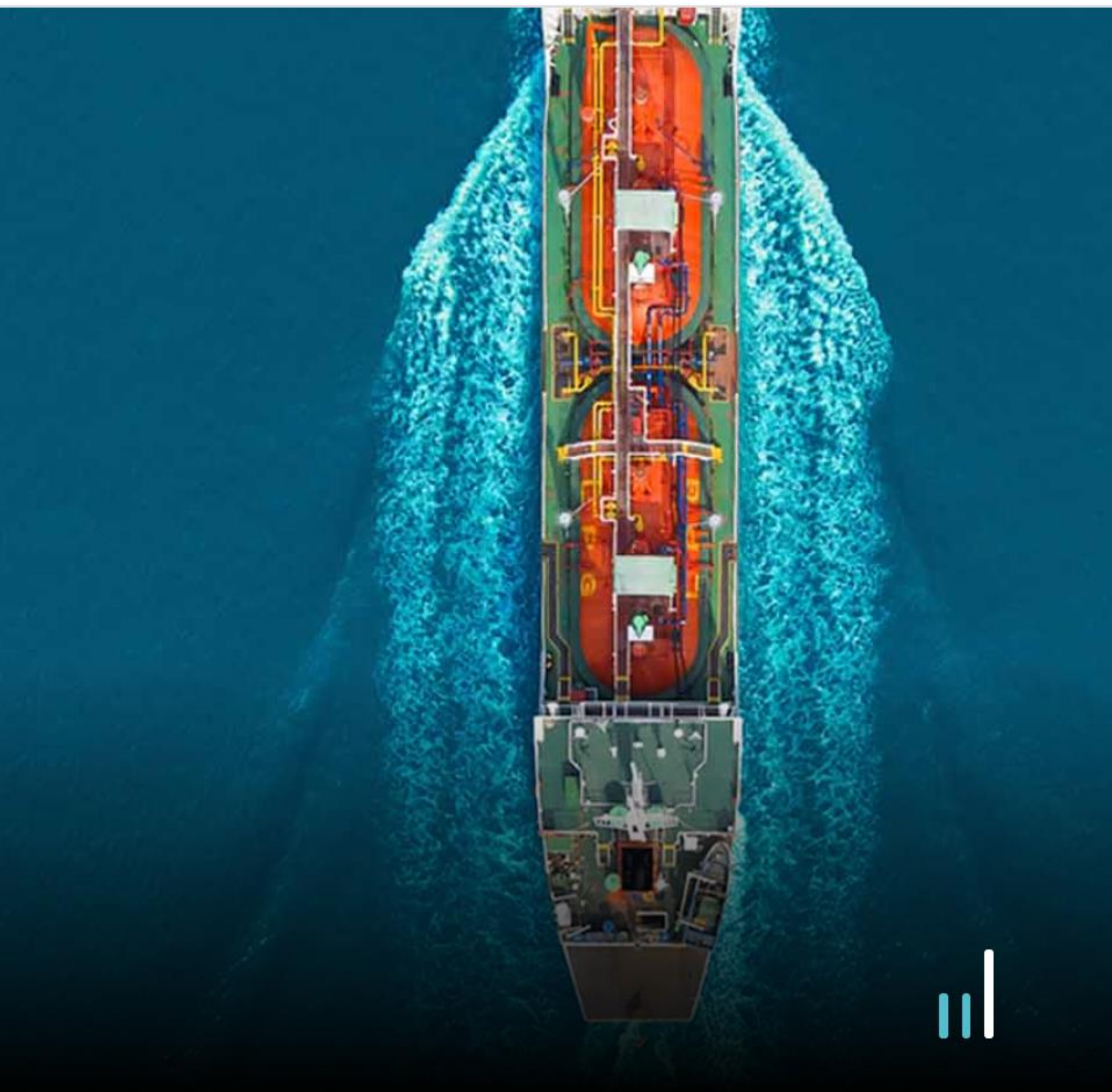
