

- 5th Sea Power for Africa Symposium 2024, Cape Town, 14 to 17
 October 2024 on "Good Order at Sea in the African Maritime
 Domain".
- declaration of intent from navies represented at the Symposium to work with the DCoC on coordination of operations at sea.





Dar es Salaam, United Republic of Tanzania, 28 to 30 November 2024

- Resolution #1 Called for the Establishment of Working Group 3 (WG3) on Operational Cooperation & Coordination at Sea
- Membership: navies, coast guards, law enforcement, civilian authorities, Friends of DCoC
- First meeting to:
 - Elect Chair & Co-Chair
 - Develop TORs & Work Plan





Working Group 3 on Operational cooperation and coordination at sea

Thematic priorities:

- Multinational Naval Operations coalitions, joint task forces
- Search & Rescue timely, coordinated responses
- Surveillance & Intelligence Sharing VOI database, ISN network, INTERPOL links
- Environmental Protection MARPOL exercises, pollution response, marine conservation
- Civil–Military & Humanitarian Cooperation
- Technology Integration AIS, satellites, drones, interoperable platforms





WG 3 – Further considerations

Strengthen legal frameworks – enable prosecution, reduce "catch & release"

- •Leverage international naval platforms embark law enforcement officers
- •Targeted capacity building training aligned with DCoC Capacity Building Matrix
- Enhance information sharing actionable intel between States
 partners
- •Resource mobilization DCoC Trust Fund





WG 3 – Further considerations

The Road Ahead – Expectations from WG3

- Deliver practical outputs: CONOPS, TORs, roadmap, concrete operational mechanisms.
- Learn from existing models (South Africa, MASE/SSA).
- Align with other DCoC initiatives (ISN, Capacity Building Matrix, RMSS).
- Foster **inclusive cooperation** bringing together navies, coast guards, NMISCs, and international partners.
- Ultimately: Make the sea safer, trade freer, and societies more stable.
