Following the establishment of the DCoC/JA, the focus of the ISN has now shifted towards the deterrence, detection, disruption, and prosecution of a wide list of maritime challenges. This activity aims to improve regional Maritime Domain Awareness (MDA) and maritime safety and security through dissemination of reliable information on incidents of maritime crimes, including piracy and armed robbery; IUU fishing; weapons smuggling; human smuggling/Trafficking; conflict related threats, and maritime terrorism. 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
